

## Guidelines for Love Letters Cards

1. Homemade Cards Designed with Love are Appreciated
2. Letters Should Contain Upbeat and Inspirational Messages
3. **NO** 'GET WELL' Cards

We do not send cards that say:

“Get Well Soon”

“Hope You’re Feeling Better”

4. Use ‘Love Letters’ in your Closing

Examples:

“Your Friend at Love Letters”

“Your Love Letters Pen Pal”

5. **DO NOT** include:

Bible Verses, Religious Stickers, or Political Party References

We send Love Letters to children of all different backgrounds and feel that these topics are a very personal subject.

6. Writing or Print *must be* **Legible**
7. NO Glitter on the Cards (Glitter Pens are Acceptable)
8. NO Dates on the Cards
9. Envelopes are Greatly Appreciated  
Please *do not* put the Cards in the Envelopes - Send Separately
10. DO NOT affix Postage to the Envelopes - Send Separately
