















# Colour Inventory Chart

## Codes I used when filling in form, use what works for you!

Most supplies either indicate quantity if small amount, such as ink pads, markers, or very minimal cardstock (like 3-6 sheets).

Usually if I have fair amount of card stock, I just put an X since supply varies

Markers & Ink are all Stampin' Up! unless indicated, otherwise AP = Ancient Page CM = Creative Memories SO=StazOn

For Ribbon, r =roll D = designer s = share, split or small amount O =organdy

Brads if just an x means regular size (3/16")

Buttons labeled X = regular D = designer C = Corduroy

Eyelets an X = regular size

Powders P = Pearl-ex E = Embossing Powder G = Glitter

Embellishments Other HPH = Hodge Podge Hardware

\*Other can be anything

Example had \* under Classic Ink- Spectrum ink pads I have are Blue Frost, Celebration, Fiesta, Late November, Pumpkin Patch

I am a Hobby demo, therefore continue to use retired items.

This sheet may seem a bit outdated but most my stash is pre 2010.

The following pages are for retired colours.

Hope this chart helps you keep track of your goods,

Use it to whatever extent works well for you.

I continue to use it as it helps to avoid buying duplicates!

I have chosen to also make a Rolodex Sample colour system which I use even more than this chart.
