

Cookie Box Slider

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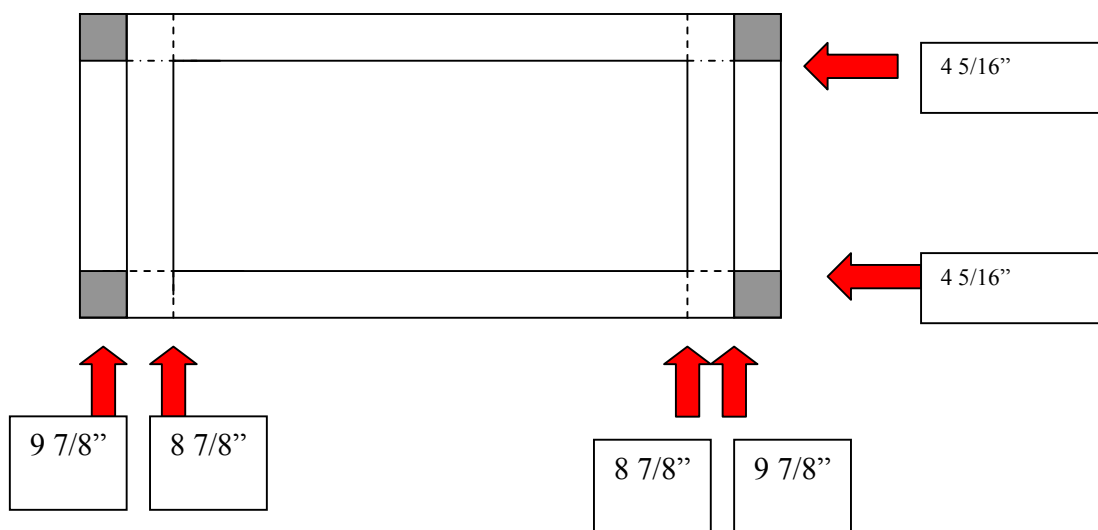
Supplies:


Parchment Paper
2 Cardstock Colors
Patterned Paper
Decorative Elements


Box Compartment:

Cut your cardstock base $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 10\frac{3}{4}''$

Score at the following marks:



 Cut away area

 Score Lines

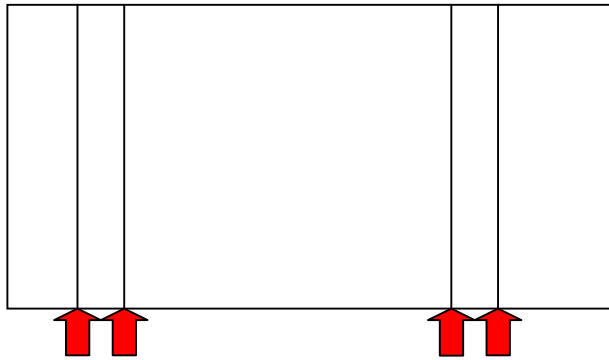
 Cutting lines


Fold your box so that the side tabs are folded under the end flap. Repeat on the opposite end.

Top Sleeve:

Cut your second cardstock color choice 7 3/16"x9 13/16".

Place sleeve horizontally in your scorer. Score at 8 5/8", 7 5/8", 4 1/8" & 3 1/8"



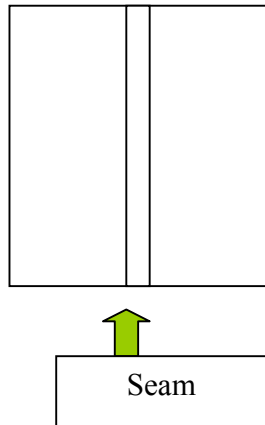
 Glue strip and attach to other side to form sleeve.

Parchment Cookie Sleeves:

Cut paper 6 1/4"x4"

Next apply glue (glue is the only thing that will hold parchment together) onto the edge. About 1/8" strip. Next bring over glued edge to the other side and form a "tube". **Do not** crease paper yet.

Once glue has dried rotate the seamed edge to the middle and press flat to form open ended sleeve.



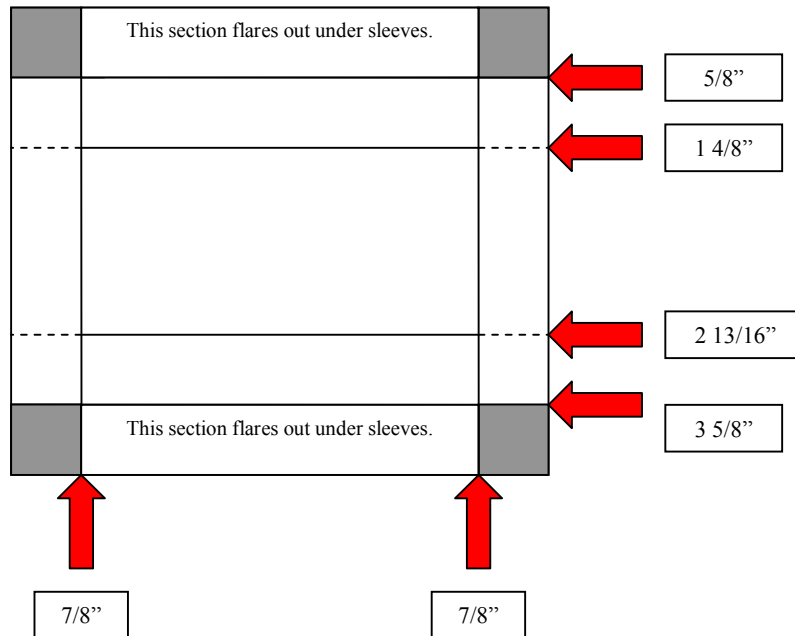
Next glue the inside bottom of the sleeve. Glue about a 1/8" section on the bottom. Next fold the flap up about a 1/2". Then glue again. Make sure that the flap is on the same side of the pocket seam.

Next trim the top of you pocket with decorative scissors or trimmer.

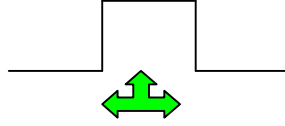
Inside Spacer Section:

Cut Cardstock 5" x 4 1/4"

Score paper at the following marks:



Next fold tabs under side flaps.



Above is a side view of the spacer for the box. This shows how the flaps flare out on the spacer section.

Decorate box top with Patterned paper and embellishments.
