

Supplies Needed:


6 ¾" square cardstock for box bottom 4 ½"x 7 ¾" cardstock for box lid 6 ½" square cardstock for K-Cup holder 6 ½" square cardstock for acetate window 4 ¼" square acetate sheet (transparency sheet) Adhesive Mini Glue Dots (optional) to secure K-Cup holder to box Coluzzle, or other circle cutting tool Scor-Pal or scoring tool

Instructions:


For Box Bottom, cut cardstock to measurements mentioned above and score as indicated. Trim away areas in grey, and adhere flaps to the inside to create the box.



<u>For Box Lid</u>, score as indicated, and round corner of flap if desired. Adhere $2\frac{1}{4}$ flap into the inside of box back, as pictured.



For K-Cup Holder, cut and score as shown here. Trim away areas in grey.



Use Coluzzle, or your circle cutting tool to cut 4 circles in each corner of the $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " inside square. Tip: Use a pencil to mark the center of the insert for circle placement.

Push the K-Cup holder into bottom of box and (optional) use mini glue dots to inserts to sides.

Score 1 " from each side. Trim away area in grey.	
	ACETATE INSERT Starting measurement: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2". Acetate measurement: 4 1/4" x 4 1/4".

For acetate window insert, cut and score as shown. Trim away areas in grey.

Use Fiskars trimmer or hobby blade to cut inside window, leaving a $\frac{1}{2}$ " lip around the inner edges of 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Adhere 4 ¹/₄" square acetate to the back side of the window (here, Tombo Multi was used).

Fill K-Cup holder with desired K-Cups.

Push acetate window over top and (optional) use mini glue dots to adhere the window into place.

Decorate outside of box and inside of lid. Enjoy!!
