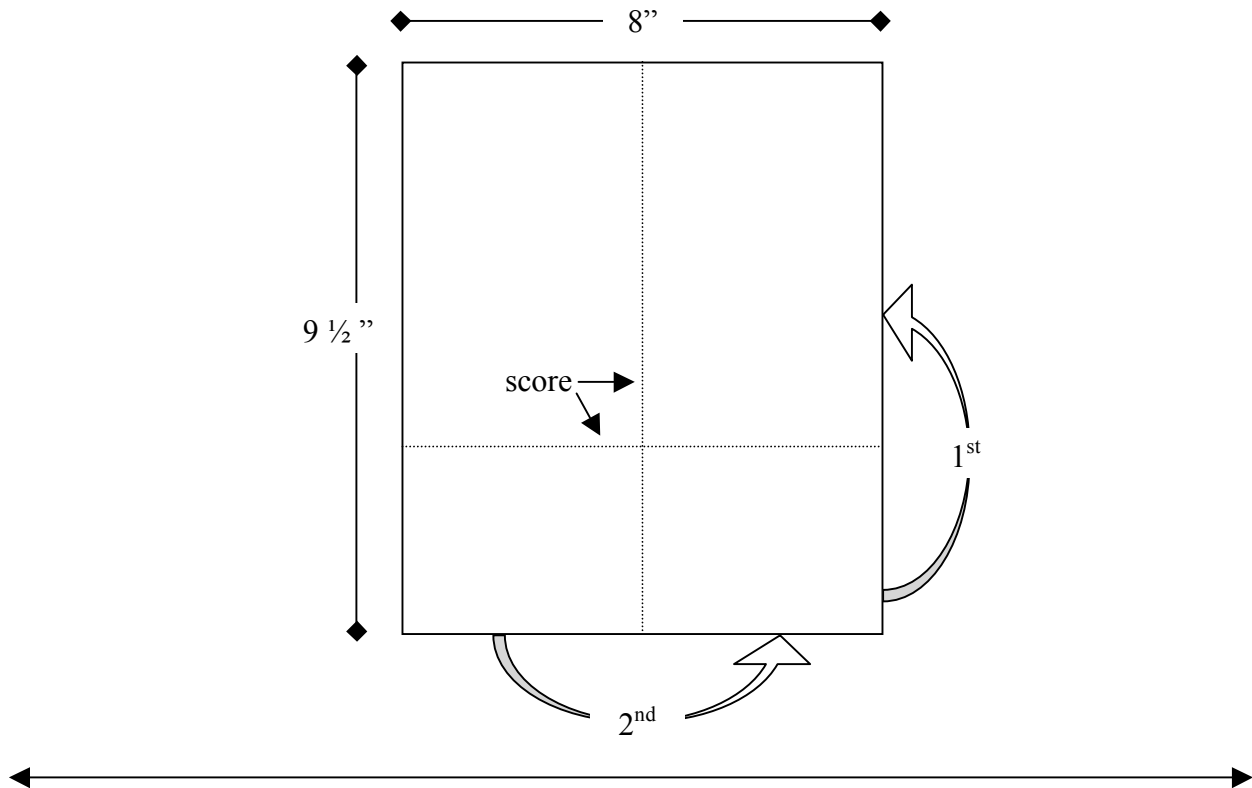


Birthday Book – design by Mark Fuller

I used three colors (11 sheets) of 12 x 12 card stock. One color (7 sheets) for the pocket pages and the outside of the front and back covers, a second color (2 sheets) for the spine, binding and inside of the front and back covers, and a third color (2 sheets) is for the tags.

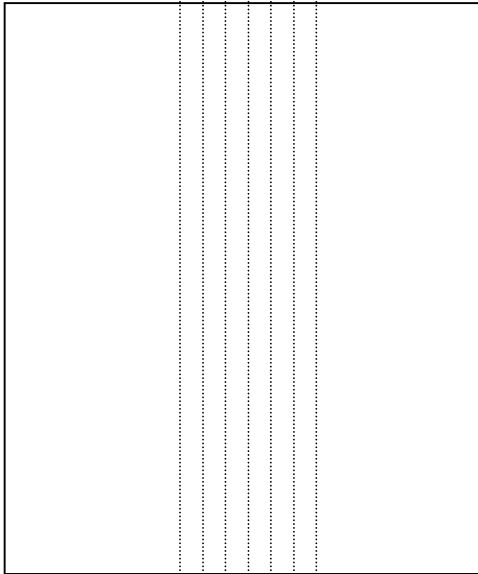
First, make 6 pocket pages. Cut the paper to 9 1/2" tall x 8" wide. Score the width at 4" and the length at 3" from one edge. First fold the 3" scored pocket up, then fold the 4" scored page over. This creates a 6 1/2" x 4" page with a 3" pocket on both sides.



Next, create the inner spine. Cut one 12" x 6 1/2" sheet. Start 1 1/2" from edge and score every 3/4" (13 total) leaving the last 1 1/2" also. Create the mountain/valley fold shown below.



The outer binding is simply a 6 1/2" x 5 1/4" sheet scored 7 times (1/4" spacing) in the center.

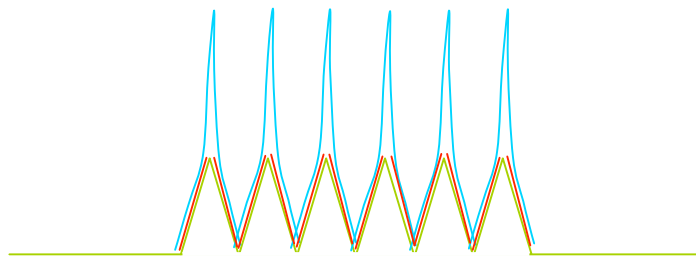


The front and back covers are 6 1/2" x 4" mat board covered with card stock. **Note: Cover the outside of the mat board only. Do not cover the inside of the front and back covers until step # 4 of the assembly.**



ASSEMBLY

1. Tape the open edge of the **pocket pages** onto the mountain folds of the **inner spine** with **tacky tape**. **Regular double stick tape will not hold!**



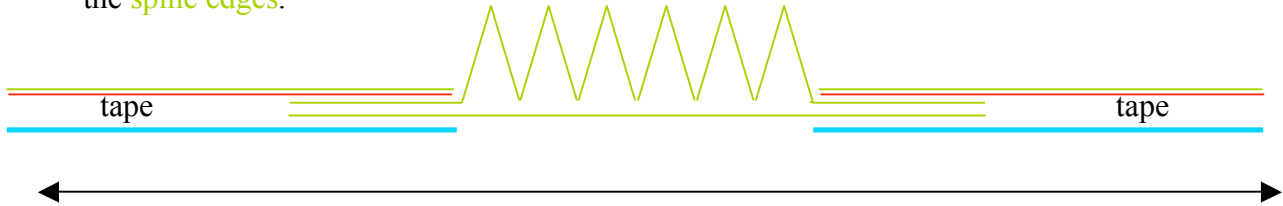
2. Tape the **inner spine** to the **outer binding** lining up the edges.



3. Tape the edges of the **binding** to the inside of the **front** and **back covers**.



4. Tape a 6 ½" x 4" sheet of **card stock** to the inside of the **front** and **back covers** hiding the **spine edges**.



TAGS

Cut 12 6" x 3 ½" tags. Stamp the months of the year and blank lines for entering birthdays. Insert embellished tags into the pocket pages.
