

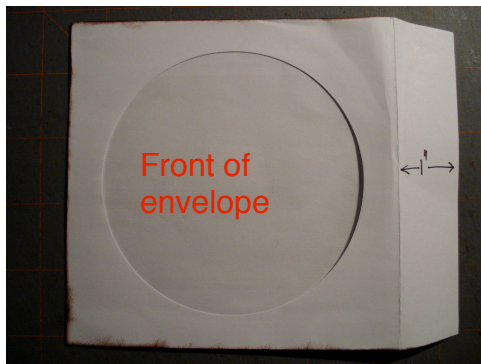
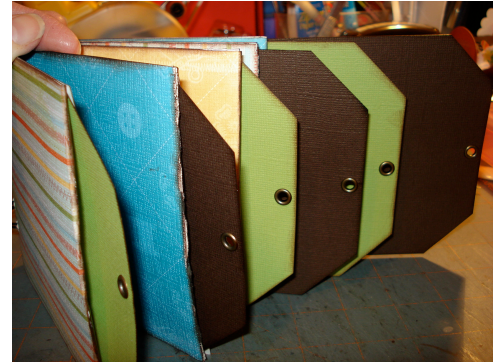
Never Lose a Tag Book!!!

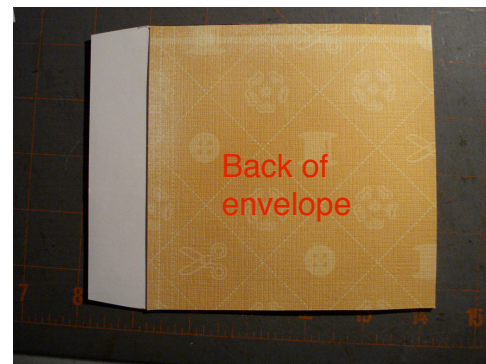

Supplies:

- 6 CD envelopes
- 3 sheets patterned paper, heavier quality, for outside of envelopes
- 2 sheets solid cardstock for tags
- Adhesive of choice, I used a glue stick
- Paper Cutter, Scissors or craft knife
- Score-pal or bone folder
- Ruler
- Crop-a-dile
- 6 eyelets
- Bind-it-all with a 1 1/4" o-wire that is 6 prongs long



My cd envelopes had a plastic window in them, it is ok if they don't. First, cut the flap of the envelope to 1" long, then ink edges of envelope on both sides. You do not need to ink the flap or opening, just the three "sealed" sides.



Apply adhesive to the front of the envelope, including the flap, apply paper and trim to fit. **DO NOT FOLD THE FLAP YET!!!** Turn the envelope over, apply adhesive to the back of the envelope, careful to preserve the pocket. Trim paper, and ink edges again on the three "sealed" sides. You will ink the pocket opening edges later.
