


Supply List


- Cardstock Scrap pieces in Summer Sun (SS) and Chocolate Chip (CC)
- Two-Step Bird Extra-Large punch
- 1" Circle and 1/2" Circle punches
- Big Shot machine
- Perfectly Polka Dots embossing folder
- Adhesive
- Pencil

Steps

- 1. Emboss a scrap piece of SS and CC cardstock
- 2. Punch out eight bird wings using the Two-Step Bird Extra-Large punch
- 3. Using your 1/2" circle punch, insert CC cardstock and draw the circle onto the cardstock









- 4. Center drawn circle into your 1" circle punch and punch
- 5. Apply adhesive to the entire 1" circle punch
- 6. Place "wings" at 12 o'clock, 3 o'clock, 6 o'clock and 9 o'clock, bottom of the wings line up on the outside of the drawn 1/2" circle from Step 3







- 7. Apply more adhesive on top of wings (Step 6), add remaining "wings"
- 8. Punch out 1" circle from the embossed CC cardstock
- 9. Apply adhesive to the 1" circle and place on top to finish your sunflower
