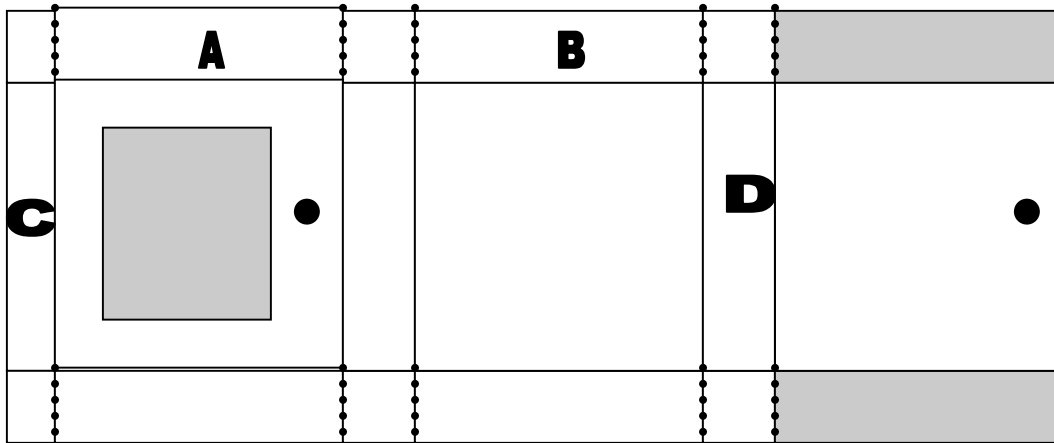


## Window Treat Box

I give credit to Joanne Tofte for creating this project.

- Cut CS 5" x 10"
- Put CS in cutter via landscape orientation and score at 1/2", 3", 4", 6.5", 7.5"
- Turn CS and score at 3/4". Turn CS 180 degrees and score at 3/4"
- The diagram below shows how it should look when done scoring. Dotted lines are cut lines, and shaded you cut out.



- I cut the window a 1/2 " from all sides. You can use the SU square punch, but I just use my cutter.
- Stamp outside as desired, glue on acetate sheet on the underside of the window cutout (a little bigger than the window you make) .
- Punch holes with a long reach punch.
- Fold up little tabs, apply line of glue to A, B, C. Tuck tabs and glue A to B, tuck and glue C to D.
- Fill box, tuck remaining little tabs, and glue large tabs down.
- Cut Extra CS to 1/2"x11. Apply glue to ends, adhere under big tabs.
- Feel free to embellish the outside flap with images, etc. I just chose not to for this particular project.
