
PUSH/PULL CARD DIRECTIONS


- 1. Cut your main piece of cardstock 9 x 5 ½ inches (mine is brown). Put the larger of the two pieces aside to use later.
- 2. Score that piece at 8 5/8 (second line from 8 $\frac{1}{2}$), 5 $\frac{3}{4}$, 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches.




3. Fold down the second score from the right so that you punch the half circle in the same place on both pieces.




4. On the section that has no punch, you are going to cut a rectangle on both pieces. You want these two cut sections to line up so use your cutter or a ruler. Mine are cut only about ½ inch deep with about half an inch left on both sides.



- 5. Now you are going to make the "conveyer belt" to go on the rectangle piece you just cut. I have found that the BEST thing to use for this is a large ziplock bag. I slid the bag into my cutter so I could cut off the ziplock part. Then I cut another piece off in the same direction that you cut the ziplock piece off. When you have this piece cut, you will notice that it is one long continuous piece. There will be two folds that look the same as when you score something. You want to cut your ziplock bag piece right below/above those "score-like" marks. Once you have done this, you will have a shorter piece of plastic that is smooth.
- 6. Wrap this piece around your two rectangular cut outs and apply tacky tape to adhese the two pieces together.




- 7. You want to position the part that has tacky tape at the top of an end so that when you pull with your paper, that specific part never crosses the rectangular cutout.
- Now take the bigger piece of paper that you put aside and cut one 4 ¹/₂ x 2 ¹/₂ and one 4 x 2 ¹/₂.




9. Apply a small piece of tacky tape to the bottom of the longer brown piece. You want to apply the tacky tape to an area on the brown piece that will be even with the conveyer belt. In the picture I have highlighted with pink to show you that the tacky tape was applied in that spot on the underside of the paper.




10. Now flip that over and do the same thing with the second piece. On the next picture you can see that I put the tacky tape on the plastic piece exactly where I needed it and then I applied the brown piece. You can do it this way or do the same thing you did in step 9.



11. Now you need to apply tacky tape or a very strong adhesive to the small piece that is all the way over to the right side (see picture 1).



12. Fold all your pieces together starting with the opposite side of where you just placed your tacky tape. You will fold that piece down to meet your other end. But you should notice that this piece will tuck over your brown pieces that are attached to the conveyer belt. Adhese together! (Gosh I hope this makes sense! I have unlimited long distance so if you get stuck, you can email me your phone number and I'm sure I could explain this better on the phone.)



13. Test it out and make sure it pulls and pushes like it is supposed to do.



14. Now decorate the front and insides as you wish!
