
Secret Slider Card Tutorial ~ by genescrapper (Amy) Inspired by the interactive cards in the March 2008 Paper Crafts Magazine

Supplies:

Four 2.75 x 4.25 pieces for the front and back of card One 5 x 3.5 piece for the inside - back of pocket One 4 x 1.5 piece for the inside - front of pocket Two 1 x 2 pieces for the slider tracks

Card stock scraps for the center medallion and embellishments Tacky tape, hobby blade, brads, plus punches or other tools for embellishments





Cut slots across both of the 1 x 2 strips to make slider tracks.

Attach brad through 5 x 3.5 inside back piece and the 1 x 2 slider strip (as shown above).

Glue the slider track to a 2.75 x 4.25 card back - only glue the short ends of 1x2 piece.

Repeat the above steps for the other back piece of card.

Slider track and brad will be hidden when the front pieces are attached.

Attach the 4 x 1.5 strip to the bottom of inside piece to make a pocket (as shown below) Tacky tape the top, outside and bottom edges of card backs and attach the front pieces.





Make center medallion shape, cut in half, attach to front of card and finish embellishing.

Open - card measures 4.25 X 8

Closed - card measures 4.25 x 5.5
