

## Itty Bitty Photo Album

### Materials:

- ❑ 1 pc. Colored card stock measuring 2 1/2 x 10", + scraps
- ❑ 3 pcs. White card stock measuring 2 7/16 x 5 1/4", folded in half (short sides to each other)
- ❑ 1/8" & 1/16" Hole Punches\*
- ❑ 1 1/4" & 1 3/8" Square Punches
- ❑ Narrow Ribbon
- ❑ Stapler
- ❑ Optional\*: Silver Metallic Cord to create ornament hanger

### Instructions:

1. Score colored card stock as indicated.
2. Punch 1/8" holes and 1 3/8" square window as indicated and stamp and decorate while flat.
3. If window inset mat desired, punch 1 1/4" square from scrap card stock and trim to fit inside front cover panel. Mount behind 1 3/8" window to create inset mat.
4. To form pages, nest the 3 pieces of white card stock and align their center fold directly along the gutter crease of the album cover. Carefully staple once into place.
5. Make sure inside cover flaps are folded in, and thread ribbon through holes to create a tied closure.
6. Optional: Punch a 1/16" hole at the top of the gutter crease of album and pages. Thread metallic cord through hole, knotting to create ornament hanger.
