To use this template:

This is intended to make snowy hills that wrap around a 2 and 5/8 inch box. To use it...

- 1) Print on white cardstock
- 2) Cut along the dotted line (no need to make a straight cut here)

- 3) To score with a Scor-Pal:

--Place it so the hills look like a horizon (letters should be right side up)
--line up arrows with groove lines on the Scor-Pal & score (from A to B)
--Shift it in order to line up next set of arrows & repeat scoring for all 4 lines

(Of course, you can use another way to score the 4 lines)

- 4) Cut along the bottom flat line of the hills (so that the black template line and the B arrows are cut off)
- 5) Cut or tear along the curvy hills (again removing black template line & arrows)
- 6) Embellish snow & Dry fit the hills to the box. (Trim so that the hills meet up, if necessary)
- 7) Adhere hills to 2 5/8" box. When adhering, the smallest flap section tucks behind the last large section of the hill.

Please Note: the 4 score lines may need to be adjusted depending on how you put your box together (since the box will never be an exact size.) You can score again to the either side of the original scor-lines and shape how you need it. You may also want to cut the bottom straight line more to make the hills shorter. :O)
