

Cut on Solid Lines Score on Dashed Lines

Right Side

Making a cardstock pattern.

Print both left and right pattern pieces on **LEGAL** size paper (8.5 X 14). Cut out and tape middle seams together. Lay taped together pattern on a piece of 12 X 12 cardstock trace pattern, mark score lines, score and cut out.

You now have a heavy pattern that you can use time and time again.

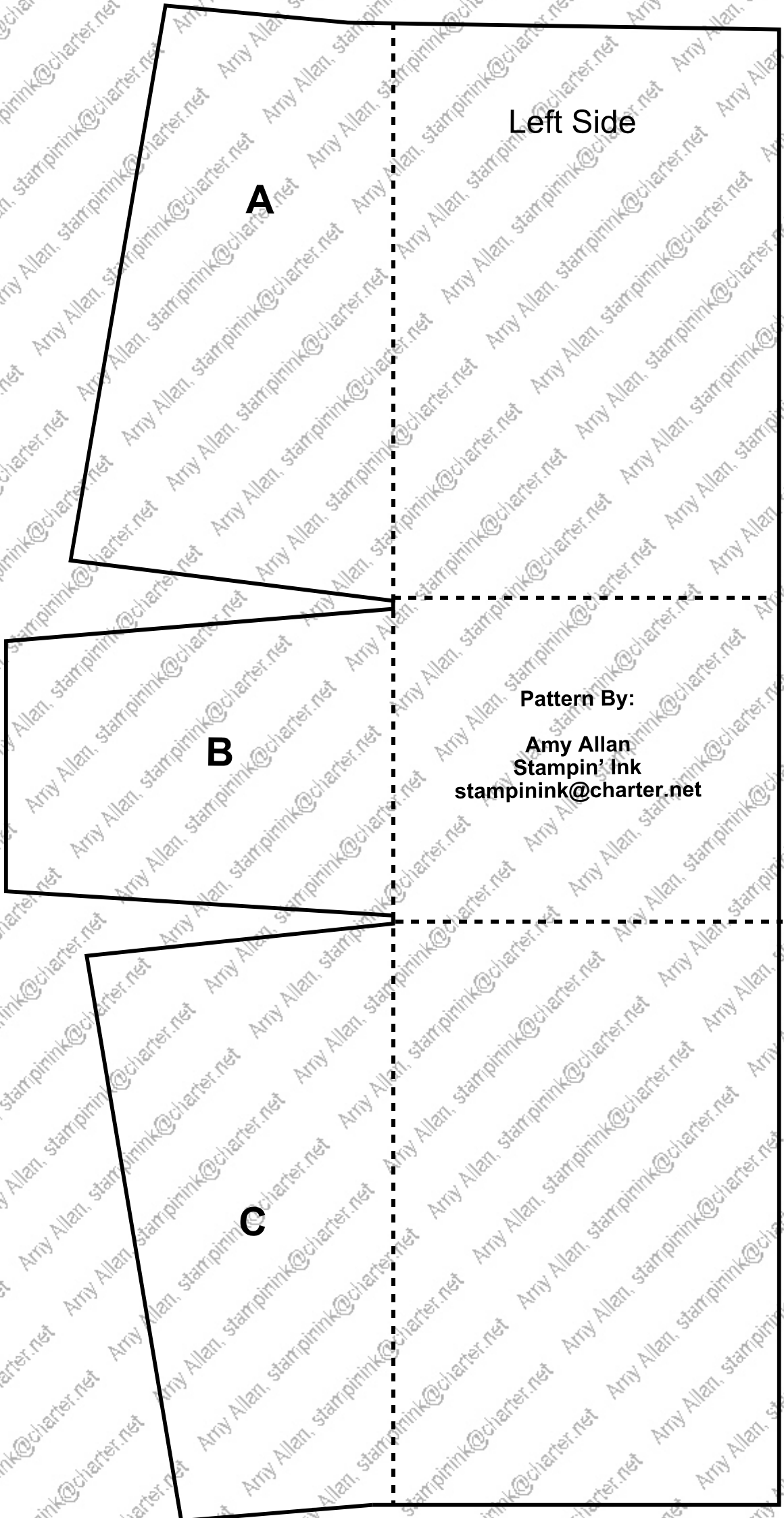
Stationary Box Assembly

On a piece of 12 X 12 cardstock trace around the outside of your pattern. Use a pencil and mark score lines, score then cutout. Stamp whatever design you choose then fold on score lines to soften them. On one end fold in flap **B** followed by flap **C** and then flap **A**, repeat on the other end. Attach lid and your box is complete.

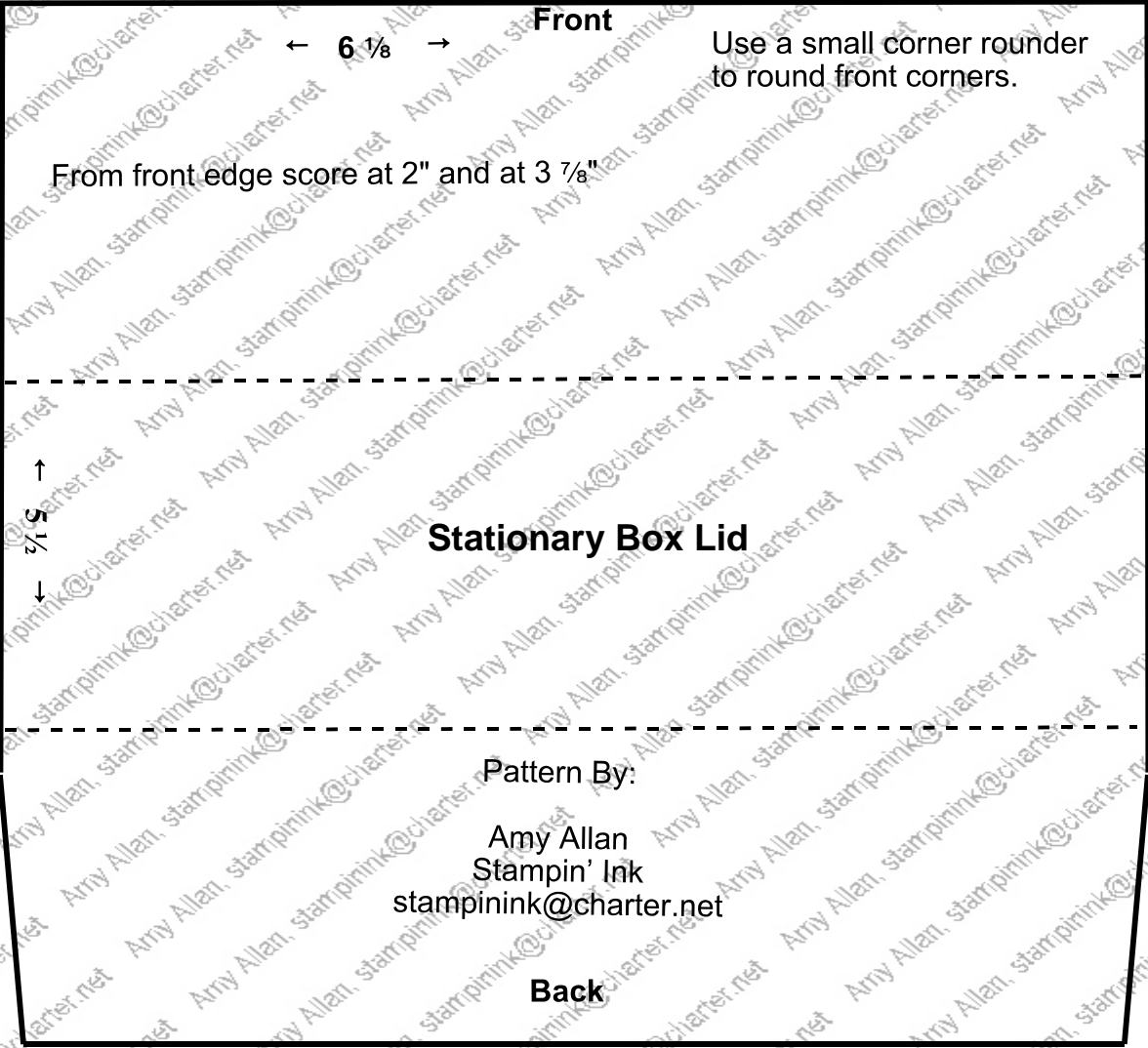
