# ONE SHEET WONDER SCRATCH PAPER HOLDER

## **Supplies:**

- 8½" x 11" cardstock
- Sticky Strip
- 50 Sheets plain copy paper
  - Scissors
- Stamps & Ink
- Embellishments
- Paper Trimmer with scoring blade
- Any Circle Punch
- Bone Folder



#### Step One:


Stamp as desired on cardstock. Wheels are great on this project! For a horizontal scratch paper holder (shown here), cut cardstock down to  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" (leaving 7" x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ") OR for a vertical scratch paper holder, cut to  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" as shown on templates.

# Step Two:

Score at 1½" on all 4 sides with your paper trimmer.

**TIP:** When scoring, try to score a hair LESS than 1½" to allow a little breathing room. Use Bone Folder to crease all the score lines.

Trim as shown. Use Sticky Strip to adhere together.







## **Step Three:**

Take the 7"  $\times$  8½" piece of cardstock and cut down to 6¼"  $\times$  7½". Score at 1" on all 4 sides. **TIP:** When scoring, try to score a hair LESS than 1". Trim as shown. Use Bone Folder to crease all the score lines. Punch a "half circle" on one of the long sides (horizontal) or short side (vertical). Use Sticky Strip to adhere box together.



Cut (50) sheets of copy paper to  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ". Place the (200) sheets in box. Stamp if desired. Slide the lid over box.

Decorate as desired.
