

ONE SHEET WONDER TEMPLATES

Begin with an 8½"x11" sheet of cardstock.

Stamping

Select several coordinating colors of ink. Using several different stamps (hint: mix solid stamps with outline or fine line stamps and include a background or short word/saying), start stamping the cardstock using the largest stamp/darkest ink first. Fill in the sheet with remaining stamps using different inks.

Be sure to vary the placement of your stamps so they "face" different directions as the cut pieces will be placed both portrait and landscape.

Cutting

Cut your cardstock into quarters (4¼"x5½" pieces).

Using a quarter-sheet:

1 & 2: cut or tear diagonally to make two triangles.

The second quarter sheet:

3: cut 2" strip, and cut three 2"x1½" rectangles (*small unused piece can be discarded*).

4: cut a 1"x5½" strip.

5: what remains is a 1¼"x5½" strip.

The third quarter sheet:

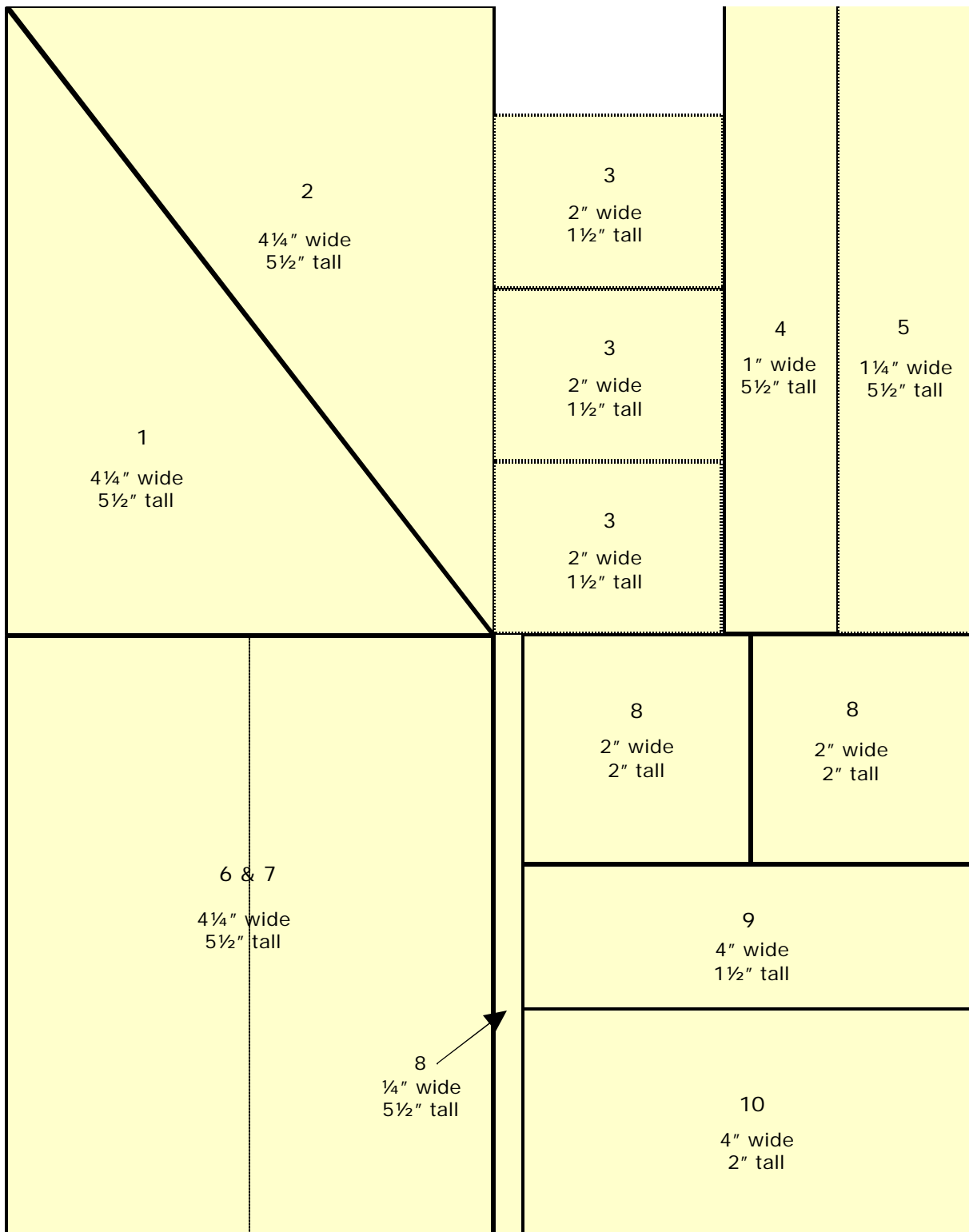
6 & 7: cut or tear down the long center.

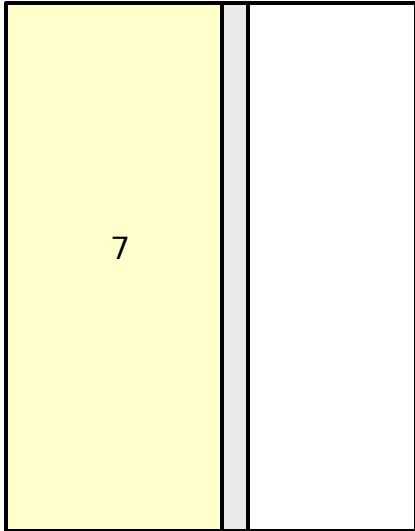
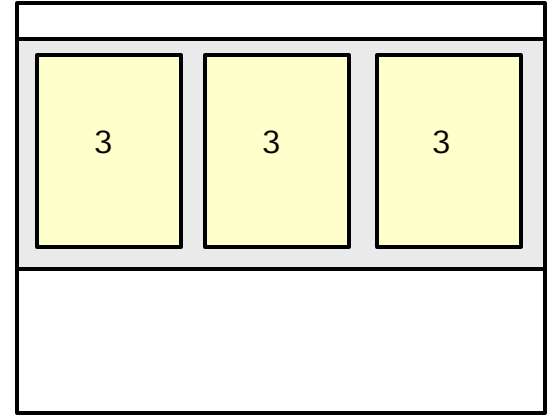
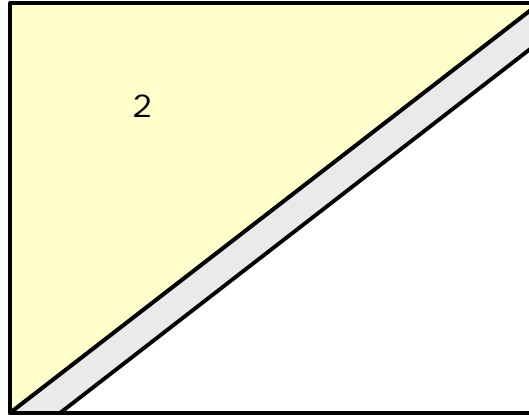
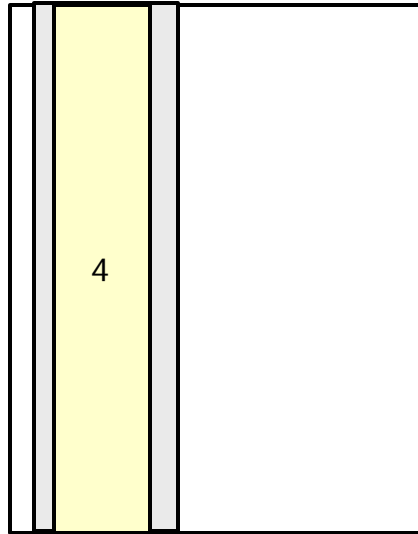
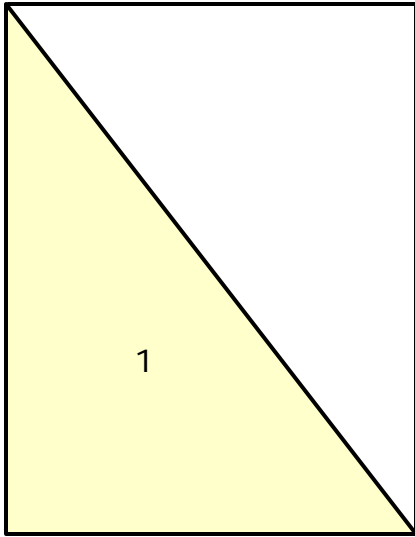
The last quarter sheet:

8: cut a ¼"x5½" strip; cut two 2"x2" squares.

9: cut 1½"x4" rectangle

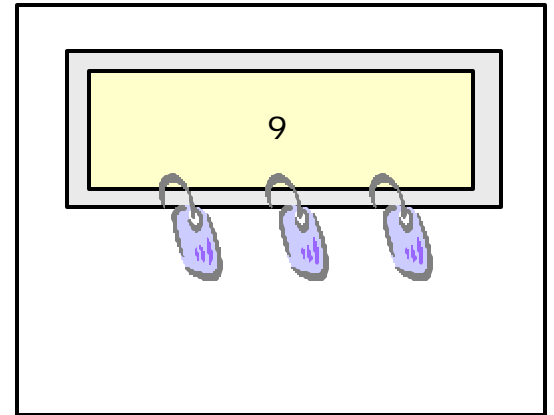
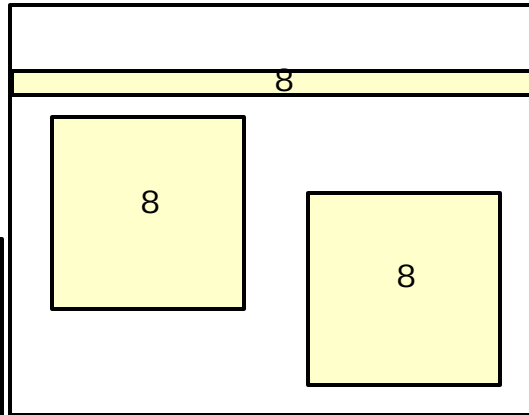
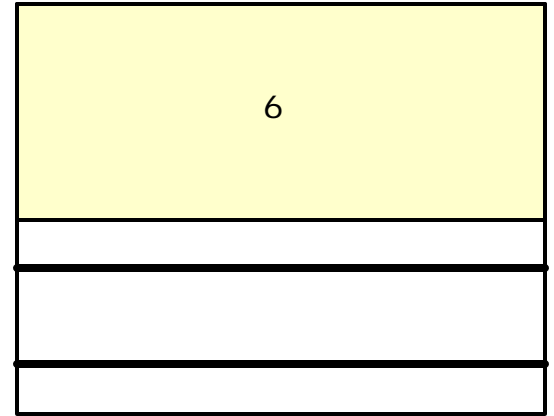
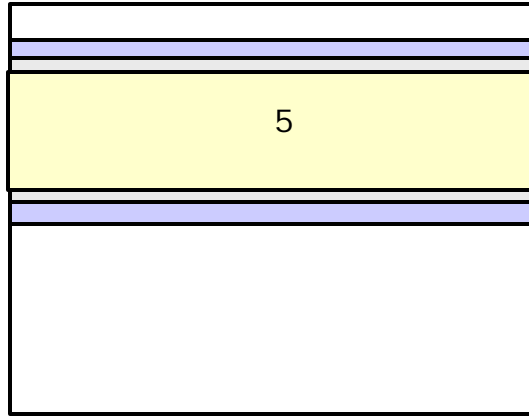
10: what remains is a 2"x4" rectangle.



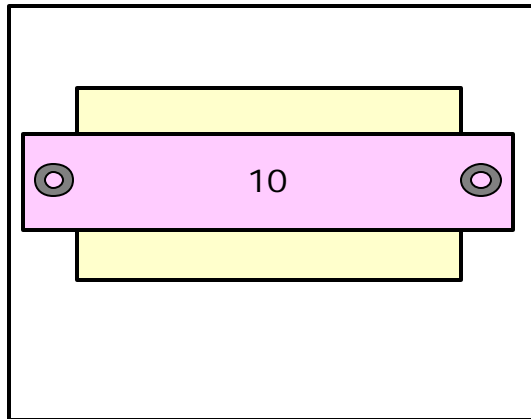


Color Key

- White = base card
- Yellow = stamped, One Sheet Wonder (OSW)
- Gray = first coordinating cardstock
- Purple = second coordinating cardstock
- Blue = another coordinating cardstock
- Pink = vellum



Be sure to add matted greetings, ribbons, eyelets, and other embellishments to make your cards unique.
